Beginning in 2026, a 4% administrative fee will be added to all new or lapsed pass-through scholarship commitments. This fee supports the staff time and operational resources needed to manage the growing scholarship program responsibly and sustainably. (Minimum scholarship amount is \$500 for a pass-through scholarship.)  Example: \$500 scholarship with a 4% administrative fee  If a donor wishes to award a \$500 scholarship, the 4% administrative fee would be calculated as follows: \$500 x 0.04 = \$20. This means the total contribution needed would be: \$500 (scholarship award) + \$20 (administrative fee) = \$520 total gift. The student would still receive the full \$500 scholarship, and the additional \$20 supports the administrative work required to process, steward, and distribute the award.
